2005 Hangtime Chardonnay (Edna Valley)

The palate is bright and juicy, with rich, ripe, apple, pear and toasty oak flavors and a long, fresh aftertaste. The texture is silky-smooth and creamy.

2005 Raymond Reserve Chardonnay (Napa)

This rich, medium-bodied Chardonnay opens with green apple, grapefruit and lemon. The crisp, balanced acidity on the finish is accented by creamy vanilla and toasted almond.

2005 Groth Vineyards Chardonnay (Napa)

Long, cool fermentation in a mixture of old and new barrels gives this Chardonnay layers of fruitiness and complexity that result in a wine that is very enjoyable and food friendly.

2005 Cakebread Cellars Chardonnay (Napa) *Displays fresh, forward, ripe Granny Smith apple, pear and melon fruit accented by mineral, subtle yeast and warm oak spice tones. Full and lush on the palate, with a mouth-filling texture, its multi-layered apple and pear flavors are enriched by subtle yeast and toasty oak tones that extend into a very long finish.*

Clean medium bodied with lots of pear, dried pineapple and apple character. Food friendly.

2005 Bigfire Oregon Pinot Gris (Oregon) *There's beautiful sweet pear on the middle palate, with hints of vanilla and a really snappy crab apple finish. Great summertime wine.*

2003 Trimbach Pinot Gris Reserve (Alsace)

One of the noblest of Alsace grapes, it produces a full, viscous, richly fruity style, often with a lush aftertaste. Its great depth is balanced by the crisp acidity that gives structure and longevity.

2005 Grove Mill Pinot Gris (Marlborough)

Aromas include tropical fruit, dried apricots and mandarin peel with a touch of musk. Dense, complex and "moreish." Custard and baked apricot flavors. Utterly delicious!

Fruit driven in style, with subtle oak and herb overtones. Aromas of apple, lemongrass, and vanilla; on the palate, it is medium bodied, softly textured with bright acid and a medium long finish.

2005 Mondavi “Private Selection” Cabernet Sauvignon (Central Coast)	27.00 Glass 6.95
<i>Dark cherry, berry and chocolate aromas and flavors with seamless structure, velvety tannins, well-integrated oak and rich fruit character</i>	
2004 J. Lohr “Seven Oaks” Cabernet Sauvignon (Paso Robles)	32.00
<i>Deep, bright, red-purple color with an abundance of dark cherry and black currant fruit greets the nose, enhanced by spicy clove and toasty notes.</i>	
2003 Raymond Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon (Napa)	45.00
<i>Aromas of dark chocolate, blackberry, black cherry and a hint of violets envelope the senses. Flavors of blackberry, blueberry and plum are followed by cherry, cassis and chocolate and a smooth, long finish.</i>	
2004 Rocca delle Macie Chianti Classico (Tuscany)	27.00 Glass 6.95
<i>Lively ruby red color with a fruity nose. Savory and full bodied on the palate with a good aromatic persistency.</i>	
2004 Beringer “Founders Estate” Merlot (Napa)	29.00 Glass 7.50
<i>Bright red fruit and vanilla/spice aromas, and black cherry and sweet black plum flavor.</i>	
2002 Clos Du Bois Merlot (Sonoma)	32.00
<i>Black cherry red color and aromas of raspberry, black cherry, vanilla, sweet tobacco, toasty oak. It’s rich with bright blueberry and black cherry fruit flavors and a supple mouth-feel and a long finish.</i>	
2003 Raymond Reserve Merlot (Napa)	36.00
<i>Aromas of black cherry, cassis, dried raspberries, vanilla and black pepper are followed by flavors of red cherry, raspberry, cassis and dark chocolate. Well balanced with good structure and a long finish.</i>	
2006 Tyrrells “Lost Block” Pinot Noir (Hunter Valley)	27.00 Glass 6.95
<i>A perfectly light and fruity Pinot. Gorgeous integration of plum, blackberry and earthy tones.</i>	
2005 Meridian Pinot Noir (Central Coast)	31.00 Glass 7.95
<i>Its pretty cherry and violet aromas, juicy red berry fruitiness, and complex flavors make it the perfect complement to any grilled food.</i>	
2005 Bethel Heights Pinot Noir (Willamette)	39.00
<i>Aromas of smoky black cherry and raspberry are complimented by current and baking spice. Supple and silky texture is defined by raspberries and cassis.</i>
